SPORTSMANSHIP POLICY
SAC-JOAQUIN SECTION

BY-LAW 301 PRINCIPAL'S RESPONSIBILITY

Section By-Law 301.3

Any player ejected, or any player who leaves the confines of the bench or team area during a fight that may break out or has broken out shall be disqualified from participating in the remainder of the game and will be ineligible for the team's next contest.

NOTE: Any athlete who plays in the next game or is present following his/her ejection will be treated as an ineligible player for that game.

Appellate Procedures: Any student may appeal their one game suspension to their league. Each league shall establish appellate procedures to determine the eligibility of student athletes who are ejected from an interscholastic contest. A final report on all appeals shall be forwarded to the Section Commissioner by the League President.

NOTE: Any coach who coaches his/her team or is present in the next game following their ejection will be referred to his/her league for disciplinary action.

Appellate Procedures: Any coach may appeal his/her one game suspension to their league. Each league shall establish appellate procedures to determine the eligibility of student athletes who are ejected from an interscholastic contest. The League President shall forward a final report on all appeals to the Section Commissioner.

NOTE: Appellate procedures do not apply to ejections based on an official's judgment.
